

This Indenture made the 25th day of March One thousand Eight hundred and thirty five between Thomas S. Harper and his wife Mary Jane of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and the said Thomas of the County of Warwick County and State of the other part Witnesseth That the said Thomas S. Harper and Mary Jane his wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred and four dollars lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid a few before the making and delivery of these presents, by the said Peter Thomas (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell each of them unto the said Peter Thomas his heirs and assigns, all their right titles and interest in and to a certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Warwick and State of Virginia, belonging to the estate of the late Col^d W. Harper, and now held by his widow as dower to-
 gether with all their interest (the said Thomas S. Harper and Mary Jane his wife) in the right of the estate of aforesaid Joseph W. Harper deceased which are also held as dower by the widow of the said Col^d W. Harper dec^d. To have and to hold the interest of the aforesaid Thomas S. Harper and Mary Jane his wife in the dower of the estate of the late Joseph W. Harper, with the tenements and all and singular other premises therein before mentioned or intended to be mentioned bargained & sold, and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights, titles and appurtenances unto the said Peter Thomas his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Thomas S. Harper and his wife and appurtenances before mentioned or intended to be mentioned unto the said Peter Thomas his heirs and assigns forever, free from the claims of them the said Thos^s S. Harper and his wife Mary Jane or either of them their heirs, or either of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will form warrant and defense by these presents. This Indenture made the 12th day of June in the year Eight hundred and thirty five between William Holt and Amanda his wife of the County of Sussex and State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas Atkinson of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth That the said William Holt and Amanda his wife in the consideration of Three hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Atkinson at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them do bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Atkinson his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing One hundred and twenty ~~acres~~ more or less bounded as follows Viz. on the North and East by the lands of Edward Bailey's heirs on the South by the lands of Joseph Harts heirs on the West by the lands of Mary Holliman together with all and the room and appurtenances, remainder and remainders, jointly and severally of and for the heirs and assigns of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements and all and singular other the premises therein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with every of their right titles and appurtenances
