This Indenture made this 11th day of March A. D. 1835 between eight hundred and thirty four
between Allison Doyle and Martha his wife Selah Ellenworth and Sally his wife of the first
part and Matthew Vick of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia (Wm. of Pa.) that for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Sixty
two Dollars and fifty Cents lawful money of Virginia in hand paid by them the said Allison
Vick or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged that the said Allison Doyle & Martha his wife Selah Ellenworth and Sally
his wife have bargained and sold & by these presents have granted, bargained & sold
unto the said Matthew Vick his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows, by the lands of Allison
Vick, Selah Ellenworth, and the lands of Joseph Holt containing by estimation fifty eight and
half Acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the aforesaid parcel of land
with all and singular the appurtenances and hereditaments to the said person or persons
behalf of him the said Matthew Vick his heirs and assigns forever and the said Allison
Doyle and Martha his wife and Selah Ellenworth and Sally his wife for the use and behoof
of them and their heirs and assigns forever defend the title to the lands against all men except
or persons whatsoever to him the said Matthew Vick his heirs & assigns forever and the said
the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals
