

This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of January A.D. Eighteen hundred and thirty five Between Robert C. Barham Trustee of a Certain deed of Trust bearing date the 31st day of May 1834 and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of Pamlico County Court 1836 to secure the payment of a debt due W. W. Simmons as the promisor well known of the first part, and Thomas Redley of the second part: Witnesseth that whereas Reuben Lewis of the County of Currituck in the day above named came to me as Trustee, all his right title interest &c in trust to a Certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said County on the north side of the Free Creek containing by survey five hundred and forty six Acres and bounded as follows; Beginning at an Ash in Thomas Redley's line (the land bet. by W. W. Redley or his father, of Tobacco or Shakes in a corner the Hornet Swamp) or Brandy Pond Branch, thence along said Redley's line to a maple tree known Hellman Miquet's and S. Lewis's line, thence along Miquet's line to a Hornbeam on the bank of Free Creek, thence up the various meanders of S. Lewis's to a knoll on the bank of said Creek a corner between said Land and the lot purchased of Wm. Lewis and the legatee by said Barham &c. W. W. Lewis to wit 94 poles to the beginning.
