

Rochelle Clerk of the Indenture made and entered into this the 7th day of April 1835 between James Roche
 to Clerk of the County Court of Southampton County of the one part and Frederick S. Mahone of the
 Mahone other part Whereas the Sheriff of the County of Southampton under and by authority of the
 Assembly of Virginia passed on the 14th day of March 1833 entitled an Act concerning delinquent
 and forfeited lands and providing for the sale of lands returned delinquent heretofore for non
 payment of taxes, did at the Court House of Southampton County on the first day of the October
 Court of the said County in the year 1833 offer for sale a lot of land situate in the County of the said
 in the said County containing Charles & Wm E Green & David or such interest in the said land
 lot as was sufficient to satisfy the taxes (say four cents) due thereon with five per cent Commission to
 the Sheriff for his trouble in making sale of the same, and at the sale so made the said Frederick S. Mahone
 became the purchaser of the whole of the said lot of land and hath paid the purchase
 money to the Sheriff. And whereas the said Frederick S. Mahone hath made application to the
 James Rochelle Clerk of the County Court of Southampton County to execute to him the said Frederick
 S. Mahone at his own expense a deed conveying the aforesaid lot of land in conformity with the
 thereof the same remaining undivided. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said
 Rochelle Clerk of the County Court of Southampton County for and in consideration of the sum of
 and by authority of the Act of Assembly aforesaid hath given, granted, conveyed and sold unto
 the said Frederick S. Mahone doth give good bargain and sell and confirm unto him the said Frederick S. Mahone
 his heirs & assigns the aforesaid lot of land being the same purchased by the said S. Mahone
 in manner aforesaid with assignment in the plot of the said Charles & Wm E Green & David or such interest in the said land
 his heirs & assigns. And the said James Rochelle Clerk has aforesaid hereby commands and agrees to see
 with the said S. Mahone that he well warrant and defend such title and such title to the
 said lot of land as he is authorized by the Act of Assembly aforesaid to the County to him the said
 Mahone his heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof the said James Rochelle Clerk hath
 unto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.
