This Indenture made this 15th day of December 1834 between Mary Appellate of the County of Southampton of the first part and Jane Appellate of the said County of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Mary Appellate as aforesaid having taken in custody under a Ca. Sa. in favor of Jane Appellate, the body of Sancta Jones who being taken the oath prescribed by law for the relief of imprisoned debtors, and thereupon sworn in a Schedule, all her interest or claims which she may have derived to her by any conveyance bona fide executed by William A. Jones to her if such bond or contract be in existence and any claim which she may have in All in Jones's estate under his Will or as his Widow and the said Mary Appellate as aforesaid after having legally advertised the same from the day of sale at public sale the above conveyed interest, and the above named Jane Appellate became the purchaser at the sum of Two dollars. The said Mary Appellate as aforesaid doth by these presents convey unto the said Jane Appellate her heirs or assigns all the right title interest conveyed to him by the said Sancta Jones by deed bearing date the 21st day of October 1834. This Indenture made this 16th day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty five between between Relt Thomas of the County of Southampton of the first part and Wm. Brancham Thomson of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Relt Thomas for and to the use of the said Wm. Brancham Thomson in consideration of the sum of twenty nine hundred dollars to be paid at follow: that is to say to Wm. Brancham Thomson, the sum of One thousand dollars to be paid Cash, and the balance as at present of the sum of 18/1835 and two years by bond. The receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, both goods and money and sold and by these presents doth sell bargain grant and convey with full title and interest which he holds in a tract of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of Thomas Ridley Jr and Amos H. Johnson and containing about Six hundred Acres of land. This amount of Six hundred Acres is made up of a tract which Mr. Sam Thomas has land containing by estimation about three hundred Acres and as the same tract a life interest in which was devised to her by her husband Benjamin Thomson and which for a valuable consideration she has conveyed to her son Relt Thomas and the said Relt Thomas of twenty or more acres more or less purchased by the said Henry Thomas in his life time of William Thomas lying and being in the County of Southampton adjoining the lands of the said Relt Thomas aforesaid; the said twenty or more acres lying on the South side of the said Relt Thomas's land and follows Beginning at a white oak in the mouth of a small branch of the river
