Now This Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of One dollar in hand paid unto him the said Co Jones by the said Littleton Coover as he the said Co Jones hath granted, bargained, and sold, under the great seal of the said Commonwealth of Virginia, unto him the said Littleton Coover, his heirs, assigns, and assigns forever. To have and to hold said Slave unto him the said Littleton Coover, his heirs, assigns, and assigns forever. Upon the condition nevertheless that the said Co Jones shall be permitted to retain possession of and enjoy the service of said Slave until in default in the payment of some of said debts or until some of the creditors or the assignees of said Littleton Coover as security shall require the said Littleton Coover to make sale of said Slave at public auction having given at least ten days previous notice of the time and place of said sale upon this further trust that the said Littleton Coover shall after the payment of all debt owing to be lawfully secured under the balance of any sum over unto the said Co Jones his heirs, assigns, and assigns. And should the said debts be paid and the said Littleton Coover should thereupon be released to be void or else remain in full force. Whitehead This Indenture made & executed this 1st day of November in the year of our Lord 1834 between Jos. D. Whitehead of the first part Joseph Turner of the second part and Matthew D. North & Thomas North, Allen Levi, and William H. C. North of the third part all of the State of Virginia Ex. & Adm. &c. Whereas the said Jos. D. Whitehead is justly indebted to the said Jos. D. North in the sum of \$1000 of a bond executed to him by the said Jos. D. Whitehead bearing date the 1st day of November 1833 and upon the payment of seven hundred and fifty dollars due on the said 1st day of November 1833 and in consideration whereof the said Jos. D. Whitehead is justly indebted to the said Jos. D. North in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars due on the said 1st day of November 1833 and the said Jos. D. Whitehead has on bearing date on the 26th day of December in the year 1833 and the other on the 26th day of December 1833 given for the payment each of them severally the one on demand the 1st day of January in the year 1835 and the other on the 1st day of January in the year 1835 also to the said Allen Levi in the amount of a bond executed to him by the said Jos. D. Whitehead bearing date the 26th day of February in the year 1833 given for the payment of thirty dollars and on demand the 27th day of February in the year 1833 and is willing to secure the same of the said Jos. D. North with the said Jos. D. North, Allen Levi, and Wm H. C. North of the said County of Southampton as the said Jos. D. North, Allen Levi, and Wm H. C. North have agreed upon the property hereafter expressed. Now This Indenture therefore witnesseth that the said Jos. D. Whitehead for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jos. D.
