Matthews This Indenture made and entered into this 27th day of April 1835 between Matthew
 Williams of the first part and Lottman R Edwards of the second part witnesses
 to the said John M. Gurley of the third part Whereas the said Matthew Williams is justly indebted
 to the said John M. Gurley by bond bearing equal date with these presents for the
 sum of Seven hundred dollars, and the said Matthew Williams being willing and
 desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid sum of money. Now this Indenture
 Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar paid in hand by the said Lottman
 Edwards by the said Lottman R Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 before the undersigned and delivery of these presents the said Matthew Williams
 hath given granted bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed, confirmed, and by these
 presents, doth give grant bargain, sell, alien, convey, release and confirm to the
 Lottman R Edwards his heirs and assigns forever the following Slaves to wit: Negro
 man Isaac, a Negro boy Luke, girl Carter, and negroman Blainson of in Middlesex
 County debt is paid together with all and singular the appurtenances to the said
 property belonging, or in any wise appertaining and all the estate, right and claim
 interest of the said Matthew Williams in and to the aforesaid granted property.
 To have and to hold the aforesaid granted Slaves unto the said Lottman R Edwards
 his heirs and assigns forever upon this Special Trust and Confidence, said Lottman R
 Edwards either at the request of Matthew Williams or the said John M. Gurley shall
 deliver the above named Slaves at three or more public places in the County of South
 ampton after giving ten days previous notice, sell to the highest bidder for cash
 and after satisfying the above named debt and all cost herein accruing thereupon
 if any pay over to the said Matthew Williams or his Order. Given under our
 hands and seals the day and year above written.
