

This Indenture made this 12th day of July 1835 Between Augustus B. Myrick of the County of Southampton of the one part and Solomon Myrick of the County of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Augustus B. Myrick for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Solomon Myrick the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and confessed, hath given granted bargained and sold unto the said Solomon Myrick One Certain tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and ninety seven acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded on the East by the lands of Geo^t M^r Newson in interest of Charles M^r Myrick, on the West by the lands of John Myrick, on the South by the lands of Charles M^r Myrick and on the North by the lands of Edwin Pety die. To have and to hold possess and enjoy the said tract or parcel of land unto the said Solomon Myrick his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Augustus B. Myrick for himself has the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises to the said Solomon Myrick his heirs and assigns against himself his heirs and assigns all persons Whatsoever of the said Augustus B. Myrick his heirs and assigns set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written -
