

The Indenture made the Twenty eighth day of July between *James & Henry* four the same *Mary Hill* of the County of *Southampton* and State of *Virginia* of the One part and *John Barrett* of the same County and State of the other part *Witnesseth* that the said *Mary Hill* in Consideration of the sum of *Eighty* dollars Current Money of the Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said *John Barrett* at or before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has heretofore and she and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said *John Barrett* with his heirs and assigns forever One half of my right, title, interest, Claim in and to the several lands of *Patty Hill* widow of *Sam Hill* dec^d which is our fourth part of said the said *Land* with all and singular the Appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said *John Barrett* his heirs and assigns forever, To and for the full proper use and behoof of him the said *John Barrett* his heirs and assigns forever, And the said *Mary Hill* has heretofore executed administrations and assigns the said several of *Land* with all and singular the premises and Appurtenances before mentioned or hereunto belonging unto the said *John Barrett* his heirs and assigns forever from the Claim of her the said *Mary Hill* his heirs executors, administrators or assigns, and free from the Claim or Claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall call and do warrant and defend the right and title of said *Land* by these presents. In *Witness* whereof the said *Mary Hill* have hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year first above written.

do bargain and sell grant and conform to the said *Joseph D. Claws* his heirs
and assigns to *W^m Sterling & Mingo* which said *Slaves* are the several parts of *Luce*
Luce Romney late *Luce Morrison*, and *W^m Hill* at her death by *Rec^d Davis* *Morrison*
his former husband to us, To have and to hold the said *Slaves* (*Sterling* and *Mingo*) and
all our Interest, Claim or demand in the remissionary rights in the said *Slaves* of what
soever kind it may be to the only proper use and behoof of said *Joseph D. Claws*
his heirs executors, admors and assigns forever in and unto the said *W^m Williams* & *Davis*
Richard C Davis and *Thomas James* in right of his *Wife* for our selves, our
