L. Waller, certain negro slaves namely Aden, Jacob, & Hark To have and to hold
the said Negro Slaves to the only proper use and behoof of the said Benjamin L.
Waller, his Executors, admors and assigns for ever and I the said Joseph T. Clume
for myself my Executors, admors the said Negro Slaves, to the said Benjamin L. Waller
his Executors, admors or assigns for ever, against me the said Joseph T. Clume, my Executors
admors and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall

for life To have and to hold the said right title and interest in said negro man
