unto me in hand paid by Joseph T. Blane of the said County at and before the undersigned delivery of
these presents, the receipt whereof I do here by acknowledge have bargained sold granted and
conformed and by these presents do bargain sell grant and conform to the said Joseph T.
Blane a certain female negro slave named Selah and female child named Mary To have
and to hold the said female negro slave and their future increase to the only proper use
and behoof of him the said Joseph T. Blane his executors adm^r and assigns forever and
the said Benjamin C. Waller for myself my executors & administrators the said female
negro slave with their future increase to the said Joseph T. Blane his executors
adm^r and assigns Against me the said Benjamin C. Waller My Executors and
assigns and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever Shall and will
Warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof I have here-
unto set my hand and affixed my seal this 22nd day of November 1830.

This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of April 1835 between Sepe S
Porter of the one part and Richard Porter of the other part both of the County of South-
ampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Sepe S Porter for and in con-
sideration of the sum of nine hundred and fifty dollars of good and lawful money of Vir-
ginia within in hand paid by the said Richard Porter the receipt whereof is here-
by acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do
grant bargain and sell alien assign and confirm unto the said Richard Porter
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County
aforesaid and containing two hundred and fifty and a half acres more or less
being the portion allotted the said Sepe S Porter out of the lands of his deceased
father Thomas Porter under a decree of the County Court of Southampton and bound
