Deaneance his heirs and assigns for ever from the heirs or estates of their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall well and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. Whereof the said Hines Drake stands justly indebted unto the said Lewis Worrell by note bearing date with these presents for the sum of fifty dollars and the said Hines Drake being willing and desirous to secure the payment thereof with the interest that may accrue thereon hath for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Augustin Pope at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto him the said Augustin Pope his heirs executors admors & assigns forever the following property to wit One bay horse One Cart and One Wheel of Carting gear 1 plow frame 1 Sack Negro on or twice her 1 Cow 1 Ox
