This Indenture made this the fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Dixon H. Lawrence of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the part one and Willis M. Lawrence of the part two and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Willis M. Lawrence attested before the undersigned and delivery of the same into the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Dixon H. Lawrence his appearance, language, and voice and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and alien unto him the said Willis M. Lawrence his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by actual survey eighty One Acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at a stake standing near the corner of Randolph & Lawrence line thence up the corner corner of the road to John's line thence a north west corner to Joseph Smith's line a few more along said Smith's line to white oak on Sarah Cobble's line thence along said Cobble's line to Sep. Lawrence line thence along said Sep. Lawrence line a S. E. corner to a corner of said Lawrence & R. Lawrence line a N. E. corner to the first station
