Preparation: This Indenture made the 26th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four between Isal Proffers of Long his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Mary Stephenson of the said County of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Isal Proffers & Long his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty three dollars and sixty eight Cents to them well known a sum to be paid by the said Mary Stephenson before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Mary Bowden and wife and by these presents do hereby bargain and sell unto the said Mary Stephenson One Certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by a recent Survey Eighteen & one eighth acres be the same more or less and bounded in the following manner to wit Beginning in the middle of the main road nearly in front of said Proffers house in a line North & South line three across the corner of said Hollmans field a South east corner to a fence thence along said Hollmans line to a corner tree at a corner between said Hollmans Proffers and Solomon Hethers line, thence along said Hethers line a South corner to an Overcup Oak in a line near said Hethers fence thence along a small road which runs from said branch near a post corner to the main road that runs by said Proffers house and thence up said road to the beginning To have and to hold the said Land and Tenements with all the appurtenances unto the said Mary Stephenson her heirs and assigns forever. Free from the Claim or Claims of them the said Isal Proffers and Long his wife their heirs and assigns and from the Claims of all and every person or persons to him or her by from or through them the said Isal Proffers and Long his wife Well Warrant and for ever defend by these presents.
