as well that which I may hereafter have in and to the estate of Richard Edwards
Benjamin Edwards, or the estate of Benjamin Edwards etc. Even under my hand
and seal this 18th day of May 1833.

This Indenture made and entered into this 1st day of May One thousand eight hun-
dred and thirty four Between Caswell Wmell of the County of Southampton and
City of Winchester of the first part and John R. Williams of the same County and State
of the second part and James A. Bryant of the same County and State of the third
part In order to secure the payment to secure the payment of the following debt On hand
owed to the said James A. Bryant for ninety three Dollars and Twenty One Cents bear-
ing even date with this Indenture and in consideration of the sum of Two dollars in
hand paid by the said John R. Williams at or before the making and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Caswell Wmell that
grantee bargain and sell and by these presents with grant bargain and sell unto
the said John R. Williams the following property to wit: First One negro man
negro boy by the name of Sterling One girl by the name of Rosa Two horses and to hold
the said property herein before mentioned to be hereby granted with them and every of
this Appurtenances unto the said John R. Williams his heirs executors or assigns
from upon that notwithstanding that the said John R. Williams shall as soon as con-
venient be can after having advertised the time and place of the sale of the property afore-
said in at least three publick places nearest the residence of the said Caswell
Wmell proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder and out of the moneys aris-
ing from the sale in the first place to pay and satisfy all reasonable charges at-
tending such sale and then the debt above mentioned and the residue of the
moneys arising from such sale aforesaid to the use of the said Caswell Wmell his
heirs executors or assigns or to such person or persons as he by Writing under his hand
