

Stamp on Jeremiah Cobbs line formerly Robert Goodwyns line a Corner of Shrub  
William formerly and still now lands running North 75° West 15 poles to a point  
a corner of the said Goodwyns, William Simmons formerly and the said lands  
thence 180° East 26 poles, thence N 15° E 150 poles to a dead Pine, thence N 60° W  
68 poles to a white oak, thence N 60° E 160 poles to a red oak a corner of William Williams  
and said lands thence N 60° E 140 poles to a red oak a corner of the said Williams  
and the said lands thence S 15° E 134 1/2 to the beginning. To witness and to bear  
the said tract or parcel of land together with the appurtenances to him the  
said William Schell and his heirs forever, And the said Henry M. Butts  
abt. de bonis now with the will annexed of Daniel Butts dec'd his husband  
or parcel of lands with the appurtenances to him the said William Schell  
his heirs and assigns. Shall and will forever warrant and defend In Writing  
whereof the said Henry M. Butts abt. de bonis now with the will annexed  
of Daniel Butts dec'd have caused to set and affix his hand and seal the day

Porter & Atty His Indenture made this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 1835 between William Porter  
and Andrew Porter his wife of the County of Southampton of the first part and Jacob  
Williams of the said County and second part. We stipulate that the said Wil-  
liams Porter and Andrew his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two  
hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Jacob Williams  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and con-  
veyed to the said Jacob Williams his heirs and assigns a certain tract or part  
of land containing One hundred and sixty five Acres be the same more or less lying  
and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows Beginning at  
a Green Pine standing near the Road a corner of said M. Porter in Peter Edwards  
line thence along his line South 13 1/2° West 76 poles to a lightwood post accord-  
ing to Peter Edwards line thence South 85 1/2° East 80 poles to a black gum standing  
at Blunts Swamp a corner of Peter Edwards in James Ponett line thence down the run  
of Blunts Swamp the various courses thereof to James Ponett corner on the swamp  
thence along his line to a dead pine tree, thence South 75° West 40 poles thence  
S 72° W 41 poles thence South 66° West 38 poles thence South 60° West 8 poles  
thence South 55 1/2° West 10 poles thence South 65 1/2° West 16 poles thence South  
75° West 60 poles thence South 76 1/2° West 16 poles to the run of Rees swamp then  
up the various courses thereof to the mouth of Ben Branch a corner of William Potts  
line up said Branch along said Wm. Potts line to a small maple thence South 33 1/2°  
East 36 poles to the first station containing One hundred and sixty five acres to the  
same more or less to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the
