This Indenture made and entered into this 17th day of November in the year of our
 Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty four Between Darden W. Bryant of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the One part and David Rickes (Jr)
 of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Darden W. Bry-
 ant for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifteen dollars and fifty cents
 to him in hand paid by the said David Rickes (Jr) as or before the reciting and deliv-
 ery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Both parties bargain
 and sell alien, enfeoff and confirm, and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell alien, enfeoff and confirm unto him the said David Rickes (Jr) and his heirs
 and assigns forever, One certain piece or parcel of land and premises actually lying and
 being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's containing
 by estimation seven and a half acres (it being part of the tract of land whereon the said
 Darden W. Bryant now resides) and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning in the
 run of the Cypress Swamp at a Corner of Molesey Revell in Mary Gray's line thence along
 said Molesey Revell line S 49 1/2° W 60 1/4° plus to a pine stump thence S 37 3/4° E 22 1/2°
 plus to a pine stump a new corner made for said Darden W. Bryant and David Rickes
 (Jr) also a corner for said Molesey Revell thence along a new line of marked trees to
 the run of said Cypress Swamp or Mill Pond On a Course of S 77 1/2° thence up the
