This Indenture made the 20th day of May 1855 Between Thomas Sawmorth and his Wife of the County of Southampton of the One part and Mathew Sawmorth of the County aforesaid of the Other part Witnesses. That the said Thomas Sawmorth & his Wife for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars of lawful money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Mathew Sawmorth and before the executing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Mathew Sawmorth his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land of land situated lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation Nine Acres more or less bounded by the lands of John Brighton on the North, Miller's Eddy on the West, Peter Cornell on the South, and the road leading Powell's Bridge to Sweet's lower Bridge together with all the houses tenements and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or appertaining or with the same now and enjoyed or excepted reputed taken or known as part or parcels thereof, or as belonging to the same or any part thereof, and the reverses and remainders, remainders and remainders, yearly and other rents, profits and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To Have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the Tenements houses tenements and all and singular other things
