

This Indenture made the 27th day of May in the year 1835 between Willis Rockelle of the one part and John M. Gurley of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Willis Rockelle in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to him in hand paid by the said John M. Gurley at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge) have bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said John M. Gurley, his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being on the south side of Nottingham River in the County of Southampton containing One hundred and forty five Acres more or less and bounded on the West by the land of James Rockelle on the East by the land of Mrs C. Bruce & others. Which boundaries Well more fully appear by reference to the Commensurate Report on the land of John Rockelle for J. & John Rockelle and as it is a part of both tracts, which land was assigned me in the division of John Rockelle for land by Commensurate with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging: To Have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the Tenements, hereditaments, and all and singular other things thereunto in anywise before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof unto the said John M. Gurley, his heirs and assigns forever to him and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said John M. Gurley (his heirs and assigns forever). And the said Willis Rockelle for himself his heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances herebefore mentioned unto the said John M. Gurley, his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Willis Rockelle who assigns as warrant and force of defense by these presents.
