This Indenture made this 15th day of November in the year of our Lord's birth
 said eight hundred and thirty four between Sarah Orin of the County of South
 ampton & State of Virginia of the one part and Stephen Selks of the County of South
 State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Sarah Orin for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Three hundred and twelve dollars lawful money to her in hand
 paid by the said Stephen Selks, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, did
 Sarah Orin have bargain granted and sold, and by these presents do grant her
 gain and sell unto the said Stephen Selks, to him and his heirs forever, One tract
 or parcel of land (situate) being and being in the County aforesaid, On the
 South side of Moracy River, Containing seventy eight Acres more or less and bounded
 as follows. Beginning at a White Oak a Corner of said Stephen Selks land on the
 side of the road leading Over the Stone Creek, thence east along the road to a
 corner in George Carys line thence N.E. along the S. line to a red Oak a corner
 thence along the said line E. to a dogwood at a burnt stump, a corner in John Brown
 line (Once Forty line) thence North, along the said Browns line of marked trees to
 Post Oak a corner of Warham Orins land in S. Browns line thence along the
 said Orins line West to a Birch, a corner in Stephen Selks line aforesaid
 thence along the said Selks line South to a White Oak, a corner thence
 West to a pine a corner of said Selks land thence South to the beginning So
 Nam and to Hold the said part or piece of land with all the appurtenances
 therunto belonging unto the said Stephen Selks, to be held by him and his
 heirs and assigns forever. And the said Sarah Orin for, my self and my heirs
 and all and every person or persons whomsoever claiming under them shall and
 well maintain and for ever defende by these presents In Witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and date above written
 signed sealed & delivered
