

This Indenture made this day of 1835 between John Henegar of the first part and Patrick H. Rawlings of the second part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and sixty dollars (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold unto the said Patrick H. Rawlings his heirs and assigns forever, all the lands that Christopher of William S. Schreder, sold unto a son of the County Court of Southampton belonging to Edney Jones and James and Ephraim of Peter Pond etc. Containing according to division by Commissioners to wit: Edney Jones seventy eight acres and James Pond forty four acres, and also their right title interest of the proportion in the dower right of the Widow Anna Pond Carl. Denny One hundred and twenty acres. To Have and to Hold the said lands and interest with the Tenements hereditaments, and all and singular other the premises hereon before mentioned or contained to be bargained and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with way of their right members and appurtenances unto the said Patrick H. Rawlings his heirs and assigns forever. And the said John Henegar for himself and his heirs unto the said Patrick H. Rawlings his Executors, Administrators and assigns, against the Claims or Claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents. Smith of the said County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Nathaniel Jones for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Henry T. Smith or a before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained and sold unto and by these presents, doth grant bargain, sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Henry T. Smith his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land, Situate lying and being in the County and State, Containing by late survey seventy five acres be the same more or less & bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at Rice Oak near the road in front of the house now called the Red House and owned and occupied by Mills A. Pratt thence along the road called the South Quay Road to a gum near the said Road, in Harrison Parkers line thence along Harrison Parkers line to a Pine acorn thence along a line of Marshall trees to the path leading to the said Rice House thence along said path over a chasco of Marvel Brook & Elise. Together with all right title interest claim & demand of us and to the said tract or parcel of land & premises with to appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining.
