Wife, and for the life of the survivor of them a parcel of land lying between
the road leading to Jerusalem and my Mill Swamp. On the North and East of
the said Swamp containing One hundred and seventy seven Acres more or less
And I do Covenant with the said Green Adams, that he shall have quiet

Nathaniel Jones This Indenture made this 15th day of June 1835 between George W.
to Hill of one side of the One part and William Hill of Southampton
Hill & R. County of the Other part Witnesseth that Whereas Corbet J. Hill was on
the first of April 1835 indebted to George J. Cox in the sum of two hundred
One hundred and two dollars and being anxious to secure the payment of the
said sum of money he the said G. J. Hill made a trust deed by which
he conveyed to George W. Hill as Trustee for the benefit of George
J. Cox (the deed whereof is of record in this County) a certain tract or par-
cel of land lying in the County of Southampton near the Court house
line containing three hundred Acres more or less And bounded as follows to-wit
my at the road leading from Ferry Grove to Woods Bridge it is bounded
on the North by the lands of John Barrett on the West by the lands formerly
of John Barrett on the South by the lands of William Halliday, Daniel Barrett
James Barrett and East by the lands belonging to the Estate of John Hill -
