

This Indenture made this 12th day of January the year of our Lord Christ 1835 Between
Samuel Corbet Sr. of the One part and Samuel Corbet Jr. of the other part all of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Samuel
Corbet Sr. for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and a fraction which I have to
ward my beloved son Samuel Corbet Jr. also for the further consideration of the same
of the said Samuel Corbet Jr. in hand paid by the said Samuel Corbet Sr. at or before the making
my said delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have
given granted bargained and sold and by these presents hereby acknowledged Have
sold unto the said Samuel Corbet Jr. his heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract
or parcel of land and premises lying in Black Water river containing by estimation
nearly two acres, to the same more or less being the tract of land which formerly
belonged to Abraham Carr. and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small white
oak in the new line, thence to a small black gum a new line made on the side of
the said Swamp thence along said Swamp the same course thereof to a large
Maple a corner in Johnathan Squires line, thence said Squires line to a Pinus or
Cypress thence said line to a ~~tree~~ Cypress in Mary Whites line thence to a small
black gum thence said line to a Cypress on the banks of Black Water River
thence along the run of said River to the first station together with all once di-
vided the houses, outbuildings, outhouses, buildings, yards, gardens ways waters and
waters courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the same or any
part or parcel thereof. To Have and to Hold the said land unto the said
Samuel Corbet Jr. to him and his heirs forever And the said Samuel Corbet Sr.
for himself his heirs Executors & Administrators doth by these presents warrant
and forever defend all right Title Claim or demand against himself and against
all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding all or any
part of the above named tract or parcels of land. In Testimony whereof the
