sand eight hundred and thirty five between John T. Mason of the first part James
Myrick of the second part and Alex P. Tate as adm^r of the said James Myrick of the
third part Whereas on the 23rd day of April 1829 the said James Myrick and the
said Alex P. Tate by deed of trust which was afterwards duly recorded in the Clarks Office of
Southampton County Court conveyed to the said John T. Mason as Trustee the following
property to wit: One tract of land containing four hundred and seventy five acres and
more more land and more land for the purpose set forth in said deed of conveying the prop-
erty of four hundred acres in the same day by the said James Myrick to the said
