This Indenture made and entered into the day of July A.D. 1835 Between Edward Butts of the first part and Davis Bankett of the other part Whereas the said Davis Bankett in order to secure the payment of two hundred notes executed by him to Saml B. Hines Sheriff of the County of Southampton and on the 17th day of March 1834 by Indenture Convey to Edward Butts and to his heirs a tract of land lying in the County of Southampton containing by estimation four hundred and eighty three acres and whereas the said Davis Bankett has since the execution of the said deed of Trust paid off and discharged the notes aforesaid. This Indenture therefore Witnesseth that for in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of said dollars by the said Davis Bankett to the said Edward Butts in full payment the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Edward Butts his heirs and assigns and confirmed and by these presents doth fully and absolutely release and confirm unto the said Davis Bankett his heirs and assigns
