property and the County Court of Southampton hath authorized the said
David D. Savage as Guardian of the said Orphans for them out of their money
bequeathed them from their said father to purchase the said Widow's right of
dower and distributive share Now This Indenture Witnesseth that for and
in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty five dollars to him
the said Thomas C Jones in hand paid by the said David D. Savage Guar-
dian as aforesaid he the said Jones hath granted sold and assigned and
