part: Whereas the said Robert Whitehead is justly indebted to the said Edward
Reuter in the sum of seventy One dollar seventy and three quarters Cents as by bond
bearing date with these presents well more fully appears which debt with interest
the said Robert Whitehead is desirous to secure. Now this Indenture witnesseth
that for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration
of the said Robert Whitehead in hand paid by the said William
I Schell as trustee aforesaid at or before this sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Robert Whitehead
hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bar-
gain and sell to the said William I Schell his heirs and assigns forever all
my crop of corn & cotton now growing On my place and there further to grow here-
after To have and to have the said crop of corn & cotton now growing On my
place and there further to grow and furniture to the said William I Schell
his heirs and assigns as aforesaid. And as all persons whatsoever shall warrant
and former defense by these presents Upon their oaths and that the said
William I Schell has executed and adm^d no claim as default to make in the
