This Indenture made and entered into this Twenty eighth day of July One
 thousand eight hundred and thirty five between Jacob Williams and Rachel
 his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one
 part and Peter Edwards of the same County and State of the other part
 Whereas that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars
 in hand paid the said Williams by the said Edwards the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged the said Jacob Williams and Rachel his wife
 of the first part have granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do grant Bargain and sell unto the said Peter Edwards of the second
 part One certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County
 and State aforesaid and having the tract of land lately purchased of William
 Ports by the said Jacob Williams and one which the said William Ports now
 resides being between the swamp called Blunts swamp and Ross swamp
 and bounded as follows on the North by the land of the said Peter Edwards
 on the East by the lands of George Blunt & James Powell on the South
 by the lands of James Powell and on the West by the lands of Edmund
 Underwood & Eliza Atkinson. The said tract containing One hundred and
 sixty five acres more or less with all the privileges improvements and
 appurtenances therunto belonging. To have and to hold to the said Peter
 Edwards his heirs and assigns forever. Once we the said Jacob Williams and
 Rachel his wife do hereby warrant and forever defend the title of the
 said Lands to the said Peter Edwards his heirs and assigns against the
 claim or claims of any and every person whatever. In witness whereof
 we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and date
 first above written.
