This Indenture made this 2nd day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand
and eight hundred and thirty five, between James Clayton the Trustee of the first
Wilson & Remondt Wilson Holliday the debtor of the second part and Francis Lewis son of Henry
Lewis of the third part. Whereas the said Wilson Holliday on the fifth day of July
1833 in order to secure the payment of the sum of One hundred dollars to Henry Lewis
did by Indenture of Trust of that date convey to the said James Clayton his
trustee of his certain tract of plantation or ~~plantation~~ land containing One
hundred acres more or less bounded by the lands of Henry Lewis John Lewis
Holliday Holliday and others upon trust for the use and purposes in the
said indenture mentioned, and whereas since the executing and delivery of the
said deed of trust the said Wilson Holliday hath fully satisfied and paid
to the said Henry Lewis the sum of money thereby secured. Now this In-
denture witnesseth that he the said James Clayton with the assent and appro-
bation of Francis Lewis son of Henry Lewis did have granted bargained &
sold remised released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain
and sell remise release and confirm unto the said Wilson Holliday all the lands above
named to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Wilson Holliday his
heirs &c and the said James Clayton for himself his heirs &c the above named
property unto the said Wilson Holliday his heirs &c in as full and ample manner
and as the same was warranted by the said Wilson Holliday in the deed of trust
