State of Va. containing Sixty nine acres and bounded by the lands of
Perry Edwards on the E & S. E. on the west by Thos. D. Knight and north by
said Hallus land. To Have and to hold the said land unto him the said
Thos. D. Knight his heirs and assigns forever. And the said James Jordan
