 Mop & Rebecca Mop for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand
 paid by the said Henry Mop & James C. Peters the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted sold bargained and conveyed and by these presents do bargain
 sell and convey unto the said Henry Mop & James C. Peters a certain tract or parcel of land
 lying and being situate in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 and is bounded as follows On the North by the lands of Henry Smith on the East
 by the Appomattock River On the South by the lands of William Schreyer on the
 West by the plantations of Charles Semmons & Charles Vaughan. And the said
 James C. Mop and Rebecca Mop for and in consideration of the sum above mentioned
 with Covenant to and with the said H. Mop and J. C. Peters to warrant and forever
 defend the title to the said land to the s^d H. Mop and J. C. Peters
 against the acts of himself and all others claiming by or through him and do
 hereby relinquish all title interest or claim that he has in the s^d land In

 in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit On the North by Edw. B. Kelam
 On the East by John Brown's land containing by estimation One hundred and 15 Acres to the
 remainder or less. To Have and to hold together with all the rents and revenues
 present and future thereof with all the houses Orchard ways watercourses and private
 ways thereto attached whatsoever belonging or in any way or ways appertaining
