for the Consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty One dollars to him when
paid by the said William Davis at or before the concluding and delivery of this
present have bargained sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said
William Davis his heirs and a assigns forever one small tract of land called the State
tract containing by estimation forty Acres to the same more or less as is bounded
follows (to West) On the South by the Tollaway swamp, on the East by William
Davis land on East by James Jenkins land and on the West by the land of
Cowan Vick's heirs. To have and to hold together with all the houses and buildings
thereon and thereunto belonging and all the trees orchards ways water courses and
privileges thereon attached whatsoever belonging even in any way or event appertaining thereto
To have and to hold the said land to him the said William Davis to him and

heirs and a assigns doth warrant and forever defend by these presents any person claiming
or demanding of the said William Davis the same or any part thereof in
