This Indenture made this 25th day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight
hundred and thirty five between John Vick and Mary his wife of the one part of the
County of Southampton in the state of Va. and William Davis of the same County
and state of the other part Witness that the said John Vick and Mary his wife
for the consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty One dollars to him in hand
paid by the said William Davis at or before the making and delivery of these
presents have bargained sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said
William Davis his heirs and assigns forever one small tract of land called the above
tract containing by estimation forty Acres to the same more or less and is bounded
follows (to wit) On the South by the Nottaway Swamp, on the East by William
Davis land on the West by James Griffiths land and on the West by the land of
Edward Vick's heirs To Have and to hold together with all the revenues and profits
residue and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every part
and parcel thereof together with all the houses orchards ways water courses and other
things thereto attached whatsoever belonging or in any way or way appertaining thereto
To Have and to hold the said land to him the said William Davis to him and
his heirs forever and the said John Vick and Mary his wife for themselves their
heirs and assigns doth warrant and forever defend by their presence any person or persons
