Commeffence This Indenture made this 18th day of June 1835 between Samuel Bond Robert Drury
 to and Joseph Snow Commesfencees appointed by the County Court of Southampton
 to make sale of all the lands which Robert Drury and wife dice propriis of
 situate in the County of Southampton of the one part and John Bradshaw of
 the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Samuel Bond
 Robert Drury and Jos^{ph} Snow for an in consideration of the sum of Fifty
 dollars and twenty five Cents to them in hand paid by the said John Bradshaw
 the receipt whereof the said Samuel Bond Robert Drury & Jos^{ph} Snow do
 hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied and paid which grants have
 gained and sold alone in feeffee and Confirmed and by these presents do
 grant bargain and sell unto the said John Bradshaw his heirs and his heirs
 forever One certain tract plantation or parcel of land, wherein the said Robert
 Drury and wife Dice have Containing Thirteen Acres be the same more
 or less together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging. To Have and to
 hold the same to the said John Bradshaw his heirs forever. And the said
 Samuel Bond Robert Drury and Jos^{ph} Snow as Commesfencees for themselves their
 heirs &c. doth by these presents Covenant and grant to and with the said
 John Bradshaw his heirs &c. that they will by these presents warrant
 and defend all their rights as Commesfencees to the said land against
 any person claiming the same or any part thereof and no further. In
 Witness whereof the said Commesfencees have hereunto set their hands
 date first above written.

 to the said Governor and his successors to which payment well and truly to be made
 we have ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally bound by
 these presents sealed with our seals and date this 21st day of September 1837
 The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named James
 E. Clayton has been duly appointed by the Court of Southampton County
 as Constable within the said County till July term 1837 & now if the said
 James E. Clayton shall well and truly discharge the duties of the Office of Constable
