This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of October A.D. 1835 between James M. Beale and Martha F. his wife of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part and Joseph M. Barham of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said James M. Beale and Martha F. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Joseph M. Barham at & before the signing and delivery of this presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph M. Barham his heirs and assigns certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of said Southampton by estimation Two hundred and thirty three and one half acres to the same more or less Commonly known as the Corp. tract of land and which the said Beale purchased of George L. Johnston by deed duly made and recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Southampton reference being had thereto the boundaries of the said tract of land will fully appear. To have and to hold the said tract of parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Joseph M. Barham his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph M. Barham his heirs and assigns forever. And the said James M. Beale and Martha F. his wife for themselves their heirs executors administrators hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said Joseph M. Barham his heirs and assigns that they the said James M. Beale and Martha F. his wife and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto him the said Joseph M. Barham his heirs and assigns against them the said James M. Beale and Martha F. his wife and their heirs and against all and every person or persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof the said James M.
