parcel of land lying and being in the County aforesaid containing by estimation Two hundred and fifty
acres more or less bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at Cape's branch in the land of Charles Wign-
ham and Abner W. Simmons then running down Simmons' line to the river, then bounded by John L.
Simmons, Nelson Simmons and the lands of W. Susanna (M. James H. Schell Samuel James &
John James untill it strikes Cape's branch then up Cape's branch to the beginning of being the land
purchased by said Joseph Denning of Sampson Little To Have and to Hold the said tract or parcel
of land and premises with every of its appurtenances unto him the said Peter Backer his heirs and
assigns forever; And the said Joseph Denning and Emma his wife do hereby Command and agree
and with the said Peter Backer his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and forever defend
