This Indenture made and entered into on the nineteenth day of October in the year  
 of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty five Between Henry Turner and Gran Turner  
 Indians of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis  
 Horrell Jr of the same County and State of the other part. Whereas both the said Henry  
 Turner and Gran Turner for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars money  
 of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Horrell Jr at or  
 before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 Have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents do  
 and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto him the said  
 Lewis Horrell Jr his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying  
 and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Lukes containing  
 by a recent survey One hundred and fifty acres (to the same more or less) of land now  
 of the land belonging to the Notary tribe of Indians and land of the said Henry  
 and Gran Turner by common field, Head R<sup>d</sup> Gray and Littleton R<sup>d</sup> Edwards formerly  
 appurtenant by an order of the County Court of Southampton for that purpose and bounded  
 by the lands of Henry Robt Vaughan Tho. Nutley and the Notary tribe of Indians for  
 further particulars respecting the boundaries reference may be had to the said former  
 Report. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of land and  
 premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto  
 him the said Lewis Horrell Jr his heirs and assigns forever to him for the only proper  
 use and behoof of him the said Lewis Horrell Jr his heirs and assigns forever etc.  
 The said Henry Turner and Gran Turner for themselves their heirs exec<sup>d</sup> and adm<sup>d</sup> to  
 and each of them doth hereby command and agree to and with the said Lewis Horrell Jr  
 his heirs exec<sup>d</sup> adm<sup>d</sup> and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and forfet  
 foul the right and title to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and  
 every part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and any person  
 or persons whatsoever. In witness whereof the said Henry Turner and Gran Turner  
 have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above  
 written.

 Drills and James M. Schellam his and family bound unto Littleton H. Day and Grand  
 Bond of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the sum and full sum of Ten Thousand Dollars  
 to be paid to the said Garrison and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth forth  
 payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and ad-  
 ministrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and  
 this 19<sup>th</sup> day of October 1835.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bond shall be  
 held by a committee from the Garrison under the seal of the Commonwealth take  
 the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1835 has been presented to execute the office of Garrison
