This Indenture made and entered into on the nineteenth day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty five Between Henry Turner and Grace Turner Indians of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Lewis Morrell Esq. of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry Turner and Grace Turner for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars Lawful Money of the Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Lewis Morrell Esq. at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and each of them doth grant bargain sell alien assign and confirm unto him the said Lewis Morrell Esq. his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing by a well survey One hundred and fifty acres (be the same more or less) yet being part of the land belonging to the M'Nary tribe of Indians and line off to the said Henry and Grace Turner by James W. Holt, Thos. P. Gray and Settlement P. Edwards Surveyors appointed by an order of the County Court of Southampton for that purpose and bounded by the lands of Henry W. Vaughan Thos. Kelly and the M'Nary tribe of Indians (for further particulars respecting the boundaries reference may be had to the said Surveyors Report To Have and to Hold the above described tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appurtenant unto him the said Lewis Morrell Esq. his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lewis Morrell Esq. his heirs and assigns forever) And the said Henry Turner and Grace Turner for themselves their heirs executors and administrators each of them doth hereby command and agree to and with the said Lewis Morrell Esq. his heirs executors and assigns that they will by these presents warrant and firm the said the right and title to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises and way part and parcel thereof against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said Henry Turner and Grace Turner have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first above written

It was all men by these presents that we Nicholas Sebell James Gray in Executors of the will and James M. Sebell our heirs and family bound unto Nicholas M. Sebell and Hannor Esq. Bond of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the year and full term of Ten Thousand Dollars to be paid to the said Hannor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and signed this 13th day of October 1835

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Nicholas Sebell by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 8th day of October 1835 has been Committed to execute the Office of Commissioner
