This Indenture made this 26th day of June in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty five by and between Sepe Holt and Sarah his wife of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part and Thomas A. Newton of the said County and State of Virginia of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Sepe Holt and Sarah his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy two dollars and twenty five cents, to them in hand paid by the said Thomas A. Newton, at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and that the said Sepe Holt and Sarah his wife have granted, bargained, sold, aliened and confirmed, and by these presents, do grant bargain, sell, alien, and confirm unto him the said Thomas A. Newton, his heirs & assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and situated on the North side of the Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company's Right of Way at the intersection of the North line of the land of the said Portsmouth and Roanoke Rail Road Company with the line of the Canal of Sepe Holt and the land lately of Allison Key & sons running Northwesterly on the line of the land of Sepe Holt, and the land lately of Allison Key & sons bounded and going in part to a Post Oak tree the Corner Tree of the land of Sepe Holt, Thomas A. Newton's land, and the land lately of Allison Key & sons, Thence running Westerly on the line of Thomas A. Newton, and the land lately of Allison Key & sons, Thence running Southwesterly six hundred and fifty five feet to a Corner post in the North line of the land of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road Company which post is situated at a distance of five hundred feet from the first mentioned intersection Thence running Easterly, on the North line of the land of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road Company, a distance of five hundred feet to the intersection of the line of the land of the Portsmouth & Roanoke Rail Road Company with the line of the land of Sepe Holt and the land lately of Allison Key & sons.
