Buffin and Polly his wife has or ever hereafter may have in and to a certain Tract or parcel of lands situate in lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of land & Lakes containing One hundred acres more or less which said Tract or parcel of land George Whitaker in his last Will and Testament bequeathed to Polly Whitaker & his wife (now the wife of Immanuel T.
