to Jacob Barnes of the County aforesaid together with the growing interest thereon and also all
reasonable cost and charges incurred in the full execution of the trust aforesaid the whole of
which debt appeared due said Barnes at the day of sale as aforesaid and the said Thomas
Barnes then and there by his agent Benjamin Robb became highest bidder for all the
lands conveyed in trust as aforesaid which he was six hundred dollars ^{and twenty eight} which money was then

T. Griffin have and do hereby convey to him the said Thomas Barnes his heirs and assigns
