Witness that for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar cash in hand paid unto the said James Bettle by the said William Parham Sheriff as aforesaid before the sealing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Bettle in the said Bettle hath granted bargained released confirmed and sold unto the said William Parham Sheriff as aforesaid and by these presents doth grant bargain release confirm and sell to the said William Parham Sheriff as aforesaid to him his heirs executors administrators and assigns certain tract or parcel of lands lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation sixty two and a half acres and bounded by the lands formerly belonging to Edmund May Blackmore Bettle Lewis Branch and others with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging To Have and to Hold the aforementioned tract or parcel of land together with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said William Parham Sheriff as aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns and the said James Bettle for himself his heirs executors administrators and assigns shall warrant and well for or defend unto the said William Parham Sheriff as aforesaid the right and title to the aforementioned tract or parcel of land against all and every person or persons whatsoever.
