Barham before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is acknowledged, hath granted, conveyed and sold, and by these presents doth grant, convey and sell unto the said Joseph H. Barham that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County aforesaid and bounded by the lands of George B. Gray the said Barham and John of Irish descent Estate containing forty seven acres more or less, situate the third of the land called Tether which was sold him under his father's will of the land sold by his mother Dramma Wyne for her life.
