Roads about two miles West of Swanton and containing by estimation one acre or the same more or less To Have and to Hold the said land with all the rights benefits and appurtenances thereto belonging or appertaining to the only use and behoof of him the said Parker his heirs or assigns from & the said James Turner for himself his heirs and assigns the said land to the said Parker with hereby giving warranty against the claim of him the said Turner or all and every person whatsoever.
