Know all men that the said James Turner for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars to him in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said James M. Parker the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged which sum of money he has received and received with the said Parker a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of the said J.M. Parker, Francis Gray & the Indian land and being immediately in the front of the Mill race and Spring Roads about two miles West of Swanton and containing by estimation one acre or thereabouts more or less. To Have and to hold the said land with all the rights benefits and appurtenances thereto belonging or appertaining to the only use and behoof of him the said Parker his heirs or assigns forever & the said James Turner for himself his heirs and assigns the said land to the said Parker with hereby giving warranty of support against the claim of him the said Turner or all and every person whatsoever. In witness whereof he has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and date above written.
