

This Indenture made this 17th day of October 1835 between Holladay Norton and wife of the County of Southampton of one part and Benja. H. Griffon of the other part, Witness the said Holladay Norton and wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty dollars in hand paid, by the said Benja. H. Griffon, the receipt whereof the said Holladay Norton and wife doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and speak, hath granted, bargained, sold and confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Benja. H. Griffon, One hundred acres of land be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton, bounded as follows, commencing at a pole bridge across the main road from Jerusalem lands of the heirs of Henry Lenoxs decd. thence North to the lands of Wilson Millons, thence down a branch North by West to the main run of Round Hill Swamp, thence up the Swamp to Quaque Narrah, thence south to the mouth of the Branch that divides the lands of Joseph Millons and the said Holladay Norton and wife thence east to the said Pole bridge across the said road, with all the houses, orchards, ways, water courses whatsoever belonging to the said land to him the said Benja. H. Griffon and his heirs forever - doth warrant and forever defend against any person or persons claiming, or demanding, the same or any part thereof. In testimony the said Holladay Norton and wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first written.
