

and confirmed and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain & sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto the said Mills Murfee his heirs his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcels of lands lying and being in Nantoway Parish in the County aforesaid and containing by estimation Ninety-one acres, be the same, more or less; and bounded as follows beginning by a line a corner in Mills Murfee's line and in the line of Capt. Stephen Murdaugh's line thence along said Murdaugh's line to the land of Thomas Camp said thence along the said Camp's line to a line of marked trees, thence along the line of marked trees to the middle of Cravely Run, thence down the run of said branch to the land of James Edwards said thence along said Edwards' line to a pine a corner in Mills Murfee's line, thence along said Murfee's line to the first station. Comprising the two parts of land conveyed to the said Richard Barrett by Nathan Potts by Deed admitted to record in the clerk's office of the county aforesaid on the 6th day of December 1834. To have and to hold the said Ninety-one acres of Land with the tenements hereditaments, and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained, sold and every part and parcel thereof, with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Mills Murfee his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Richard Barrett for himself and his heirs the said Ninety-one acres of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Mills Murfee his heirs and assigns free from the claims of him the said Richard Barrett his heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall with and do warrant and favour defend by these presents. Myrick in all the Land which his father William Myrick died seized and possessed of, to have and to hold to his heirs forever from this day thenceforward and forever. And the said William Myrick, trustee for the said Joshua F. Myrick his heirs, executors and assigns doth warrant and defend the right title, interest, claims and demands of any other person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof I the said William A. Myrick hath hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written.
