This Indenture made and entered into on this 16th day of November in  
the year of our Lord, Eighteen hundred and thirty-five between Henry Hundred of  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Barnes  
of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry  
Hundred for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-eight dollars and twenty  
five cents current money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said  
Jacob Barnes, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents  
doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confit unto him the said Jacob Barnes  
his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land, situate lying and  
being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & Parish of Saint Luke, containing by  
a recent survey twenty eight acres (be the same more or less) and bounded as follows,  
to wit, beginning at a pine standing in a small branch, a new corner for the  
Jacob Barnes and Henry Hundred, thence along said Jacob Barnes line of marked  
trees 144° E. 8 poles to a pine, thence 1.42° E. 17 poles to a pine thence 1.97°  
E. 11 poles to a pine thence 1.63/4° E. 36 poles, thence 1.35 1/2° E. 8 poles to a pine  
thence 1.7° E. 4 poles to a Spanish Oak, thence 1.9° N. 8 poles to the end of  
branch a corner in Valley Creek all seed line, thence up the run of said Branch  
along her line 39 poles to a black gum, a corner for John Bryant, thence along  
his line N 6 3/4° E. 85 1/2 poles to a lightwood post a new corner for said Henry  
Hundred, thence along his line 1.87 1/2 N. 35 poles to a black gum standing in the last  
mentioned branch thence down the run of said branch 44 poles to the first station  
together with all right title interest, claim or demand of in and to the aforesaid tract  
& parcel of land and premises, with its appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any  
wise appertaining. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of  
land and premises, with all and singular its appurtenances, unto him the said Jacob  
Barnes his heirs and assigns forever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of  
him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Jacob  
Barnes, for himself his heirs, Executors, and administrators with hereby covenant and agree,  
to and will the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Executors, Administrators and assigns that he  
will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the
