This Indenture made and entered into on this 16th day of November in
 the year of our Lord, Eighteen hundred and thirty-five between Henry Kinross of
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Barnes
 of the same County and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry
 Kinross for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-eight dollars and seven
 pence current money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said
 Jacob Barnes, at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents
 with grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm unto him the said Jacob Barnes
 his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land, situate lying, and
 being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & Parish of Saint Lukes, containing by
 a recent survey, twenty eight acres (be the same more or less) and bounded as fol-
 lows, to wit, Beginning, at a pine standing in a small branch, a new corner for said
 Jacob Barnes and Henry Kinross, thence along said Jacob Barnes line of marked
 trees S 44° E. 8 poles to a pine, thence S 42° E. 17 poles to a pine thence S 37°
 E. 11 poles to a pine thence S 6 3/4° E. 36 poles, thence S. 25 1/2° E. 8 poles to a pine,
 thence S. 7° E. 4 poles to a Spanish Oak, thence S 9° N. 8 poles to the run of
 branch a corner in Valley Court decd. line, thence up the run of said branch
 along her line 39 poles to a black gum, a corner for John Probert, thence along
 his line N 6 1/4° E. 85 1/2 poles to a lightwood post a new corner for said Henry
 Kinross, thence along his line S 87 1/2° N. 35 poles to a black gum standing in the first
 mentioned branch thence across the run of said branch 4 1/2 poles to the first corner
 together with all right, title interest, claim or demand of in and to the above tract
 & parcel of land and premises, with its appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any
 wise appertaining; To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of
 Land and premises, with all and singular its appurtenances, unto him the said Jacob
 Barnes his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of
 him, the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever) And the said Henry
 Kinross, for himself his heirs, Executors, and assigns with hereby covenant and agree
 to and with the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Executors, and assigns that he
 will by these presents warrant and forever defend the right and title of the
