acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Lewis Norrell Junr his
heirs and assigns forever, One certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and be-
ing in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes containing by a
late Survey one hundred and forty acres be the same more or less it being part of the Land
belonging to the Nottoway tribe of Indians, and laid off to the said Henry Turners and
Ann Turners by Jeremiah Cobb Esqr Tho R Gray and William R Edwards, Commissioners
appointed by an order of the County Court of Southampton for that purpose and
bounded by the lands of Henry B. Vaughan, Thomas Piddley and the Nottoway tribe
of Indians for further particulars respecting the boundaries reference may be had to
the said Commissioners Report. To have and to hold the above described tract or
parcel of Land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise
appertaining, unto him the said Lewis Norrell Junr his heirs and assigns forever
to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Lewis Norrell Junr
his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Henry Turners and Ann Turners his
Wife for themselves their heirs Executors and Admins. do and each of them doth hereby
covenant and agree to and with the said Lewis Norrell Junr his heirs Executors, Admins.
